I hope you are well and had a lovely Spring Break. We wanted to write to you with a few important dates and messages now we are getting close to the GCSE exams.

On Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May all year 11 students will sit their English Literature exam at 9:00am. During period 4 all students will have a science 'booster' session in preparation for their biology exam on 12<sup>th</sup> May. During period 5 all students will have a maths 'booster' session in preparation for their maths exam on 14<sup>th</sup> May.

Monday 11<sup>th</sup> will be the last day of lessons. After this date we will only expect students to come into school for their exams. If students have a morning exam they need to be in school at 8:15am. They will sign in with a member of SLT. We will contact you by 8:45am if they are not in school. Students will be dismissed after their exam and allowed to leave the school site.

If students have an afternoon exam they are expected in school at 12:45pm. They will enter via reception and must make their way straight to Norris Hall where they will sign in. If your child has not arrived by 1:15pm we will contact you.

All students received a printed copy of their individual exam timetable today.

Some subjects will be running booster sessions during the study leave period. Heads of Faculty will arrange these over the next few weeks and both you and your child will be informed of these sessions via Edulink. It would be incredibly helpful if you could please encourage your child to attend any sessions they are invited to.

Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June - Leavers' Day from 1:00pm.
