Come to WSfG with the knowledge that it is a safe space despite it being bigger than primary school. You will make some of the best friends you will ever have in your 5 years.




I remember feeling excited but overwhelmed and got lost all the time. Of course after a few weeks I was settled.

Take advantage of all the incredible opportunities that the teachers will provide you! They all want the best for you!









This is what your new school day will be like
