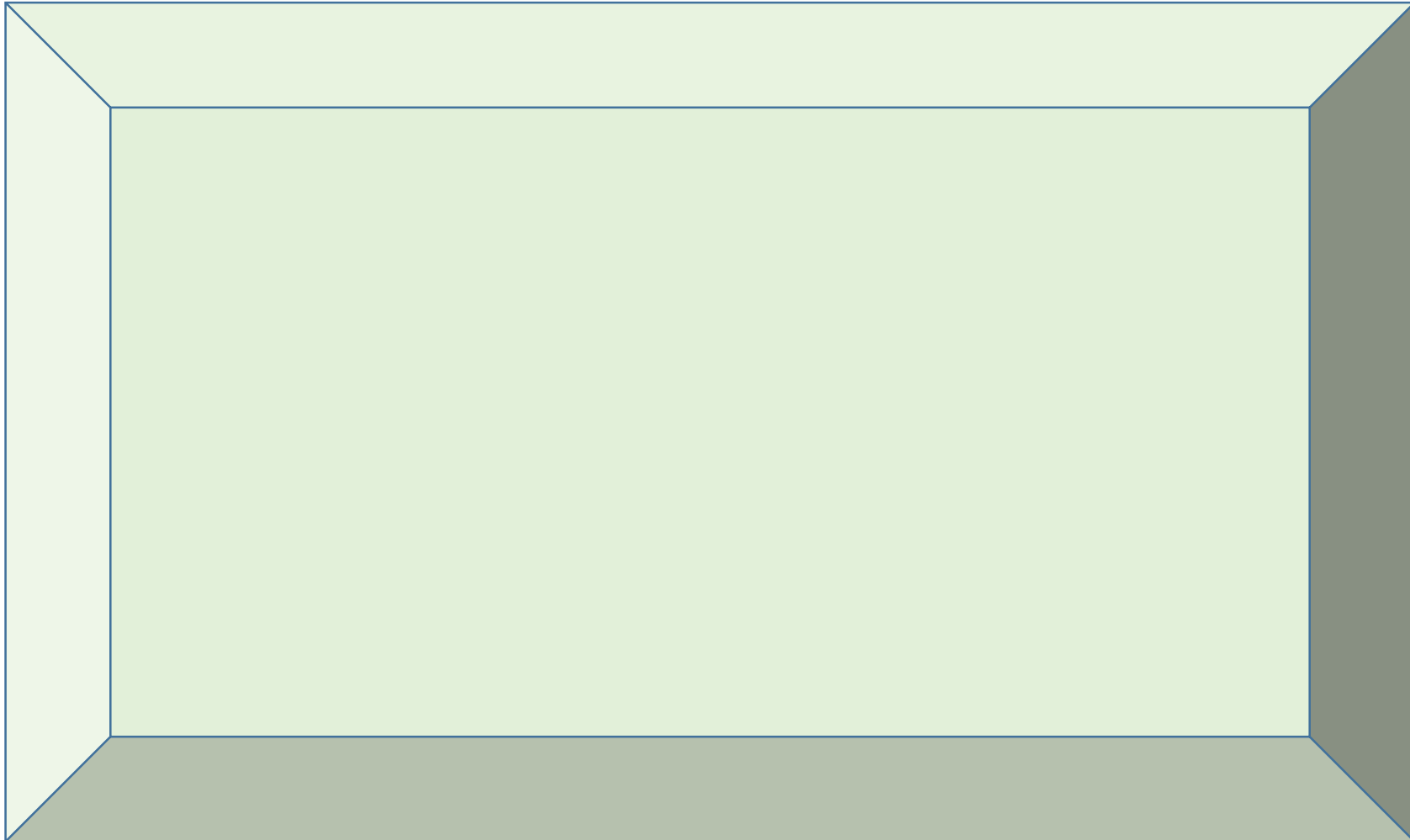

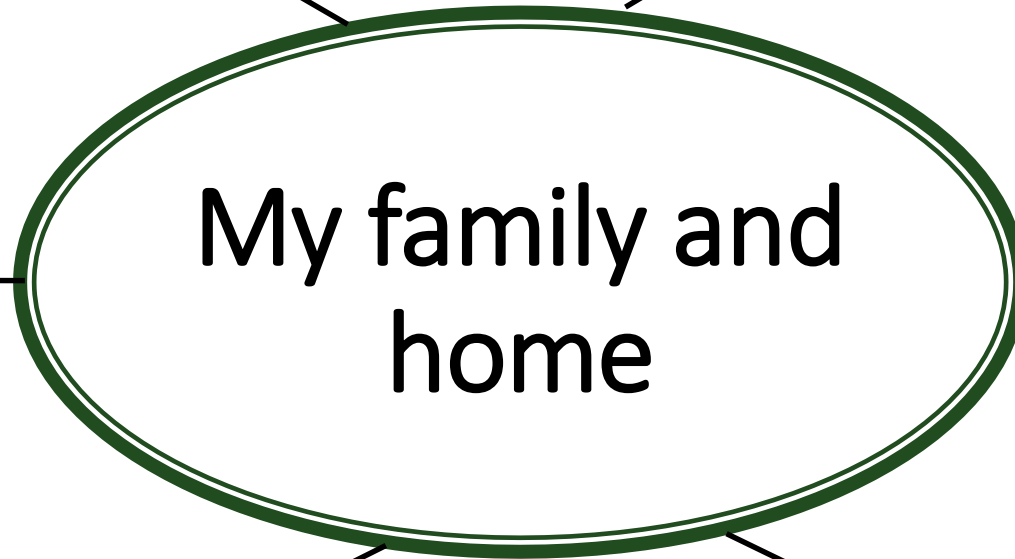

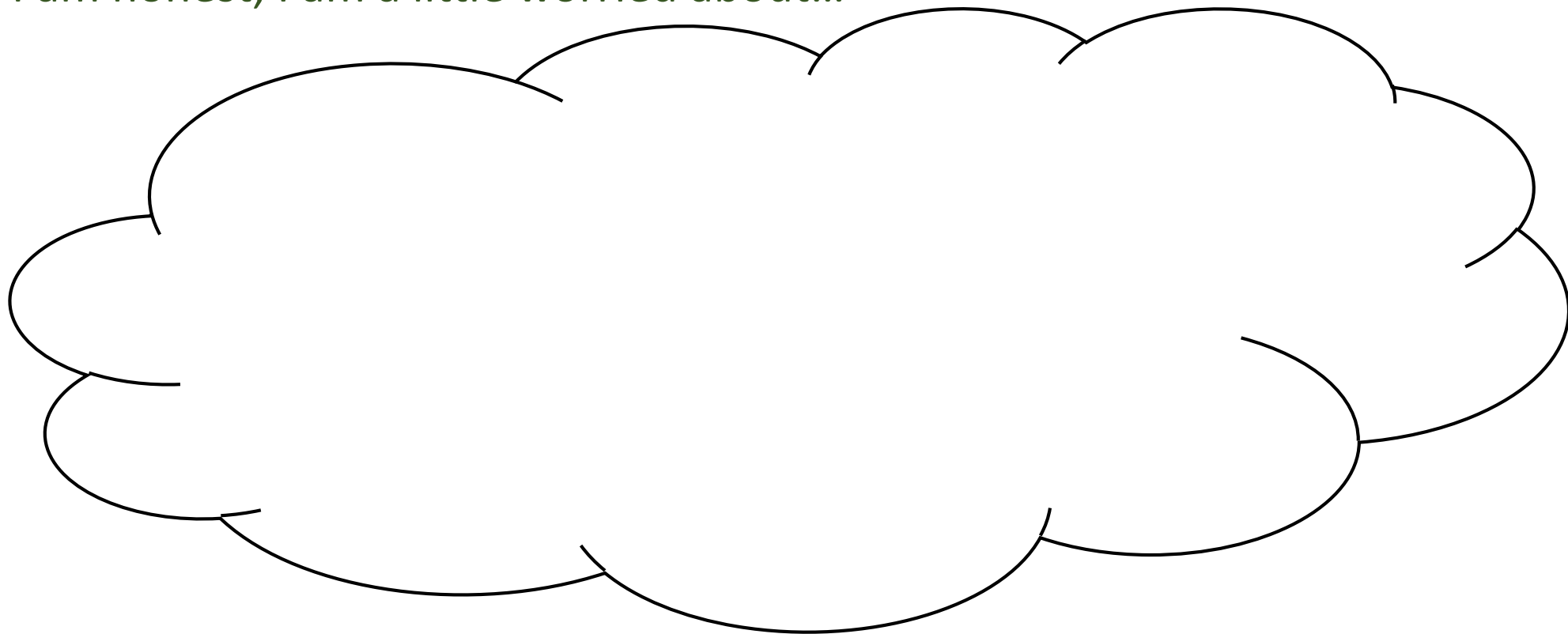

- Clubs take place at lunchtimes and after school.

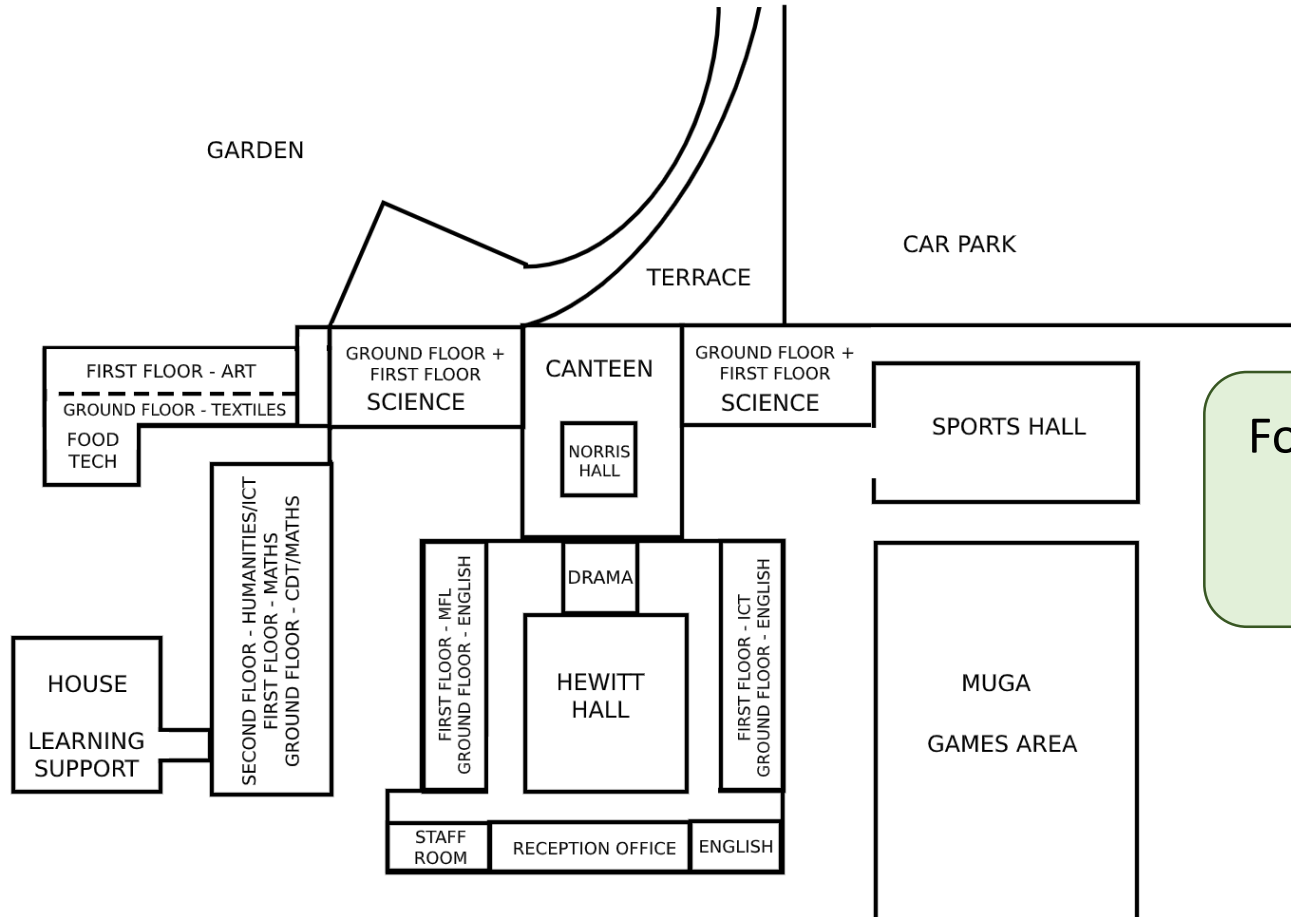
