Assessment Fortnight: 16th May - 27th May 2022

All students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will be taking summer assessments in English, Humanities, Maths, MFL and Science.

This booklet outlines the type of assessment and the length and focus of each assessment so that you know what to expect in each subject and so that you can prepare yourself.

- Assessments will be held in normal lesson time when you are timetabled for the subject and will be in your normal classroom. Two weeks before the assessment fortnight, your class teacher will be able to tell you which lesson the examination will be held in. You will have a timetable so that you can fill in all of your assessments. This will help you to stay organised, be prepared and reduce stress.
- When the assessment is going to begin the teacher will explain that the class are to remain in 'examination conditions'. This means you are to remain in absolute silence and listen carefully to instructions. Do not interrupt instructions wait until the teacher asks if there are any questions then raise your hand.
- We will use these assessments to understand where you are at in your learning and to see how we can best support your progress. They may also help some subjects, such as Maths, to make sure you are in the right group for you.

All other subjects are assessed throughout the year. This may be through end of unit tests, project work or ongoing assessments. These assessments will inform the teachers of students' progress and form the basis of what we report to you.

Science

Assessment type: Examination

Number of assessments: 2

Length of each assessment 45 minutes

This assessment will assess students' knowledge and understanding of:

- ♦ Paper I English Literature: The Tempest
- ♦ Paper 2 Language: Creative Writing

Students should prepare for this by:

- Revising key characters and themes in Shakespeare play studied.

 Analysing language and effect.
- Writing imaginative and engaging short stories; including interesting characters, effective dialogue and thoughtful plotline.

Humanities

Assessment type: Examination

Number of assessments: |

Length of assessment: 50 minutes

Format

Section A: Geography (15 marks),

Section B: History (15 marks)

Section C: Religious Studies (15 marks)

Each section will have a combination of short answer knowledge based questions and extended questions, ending with an essay linked to the topic. Students will need to answer all questions

Timing

50 minutes (15 minutes per section plus 5 minutes reading and checking time)

This assessment will assess students' understanding of:

Geography: Population, resources and environmental issues (15 marks):

- General geographical skills e.g. compass points, grid references, distance and scale:
- ♦ Reasons for population growth (both natural increase and migration)
- ♦ The problems with resourcing a growing population;
- ♦ Managing population growth (including population policies);
- ♦ Environmental issues created by our growing population (e.g. global warming, deforestation, overfishing).

<u>History</u>: Making of the UK (15 marks):

- ♦ The reasons for Henry VIII's break from Rome in 1534;
- ♦ The slave triangle and the middle passage;
- ♦ Life on plantations;
- ♦ The abolition of slavery.

Dual Languages: Second Year French/Spanish

Assessment type: French—Reading and Speaking, Spanish—Listening and Speaking

Number of assessment: 2

Length of assessment: I paper (reading/listening) of approximately 45 minutes and a 2-4 minutes speaking assessment.

• Geometry: Calculate perimeter and area of quadrilaterals

• Numbers: Order of operations

Fractions and percentages of an amount

Ordering numbers Directed numbers

Mixed numbers and improper fractions

Arithmetic with fractions
