## KS3 Assessment 2021-2022

Each academic year, students complete an end of year assessment in most subject areas. This is one of the ways in which we monitor the progress they have made in each subject.

The Key Stage 3 assessment window opens on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May and closes on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May. The assessments which students will be sitting will vary from one subject area to another and may include practical, spoken and written assessments. All assessments will take place in classrooms during usual lesson time.

We know that parents will want to ensure their child is prepared for these assessments and that they have the necessary information. We are therefore providing assessment booklets which outline both what will be assessed and how it will be assessed in each subject area. We trust that this will enable you to support your child with their preparation.

Students will be given an exam timetable for the fortnight, which they will complete as their teachers inform them of their class assessment date and the test topics. You will understand that this will vary from class to class since students have different subjects at different times and assessments are lesson-based. I have included a link to a blank copy of that timetable above, so that you can track your child's assessments.

In addition, to make sure our students are organised and prepared, Mr Shackson will be delivering a presentation to students on exam conduct and preparation. This will be shared on the website by the end of the week.
