All students have been provided with a paper copy of the college information sheet during form today. This sheet provides each student with basic information that they will need for their upcoming applications to college. At this early stage in Year 11, the information we are providing is predicted grades which teachers have made based upon Year 10 summer mock exams.

This term, our focus will be on supporting your child to work towards their mock exams in November. You will receive new, updated predictions for your child in January, following the Year 11 mock exams. These results are the ones that will need to be sent to colleges; if they ask.
