To learn about some typical French food in order to be able to order in French at a café.	To be able to say what I am going to do next weekend using the near future tense.	To learn about Easter traditions in French speaking countries.	To learn how to talk about your town using a range of opinions and the present, past and future tenses.
Formative Assessment	To take part in a speaking role play on ordering in a French café.
