Summative Assessment	 During this module, we will assess two skills; listening and writing. To be able to write a short text giving and seeking information and opinions, using the present and past or future tenses. To be able to translate shorts sentences into French. To be able to understand a range of short passages which include opinions with basic reasons, in either the present and the past, or the present and the future tense. To be able to transcribe short sentences.
