<b>Main learning steps</b>	To learn about festivals in the French-speaking world	To talk about your festivals and celebrations and what you like and dislike; to practise <i>–re</i> and <i>–ir</i> verbs	To describe in more detail what happens during the festival	To use transactional language when buying food in a market; present tense of <i>vouloir</i>	To learn about traditional food for celebrations and in different French-speaking countries	To talk about a future trip using the near future tense; to practise asking questions	To have a knowledge about festivals in French-speaking countries and to be able to talk about your own celebrations
<b>Formative Assessment</b>	To be able to give a one-minute presentation on a chosen celebration using opinions and two tenses.						
<b>Summative Assessment</b>	During this module, we will assess one skill; reading. 1. To be able to understand a range of short and longer texts which include opinions and the present, past and future tenses. To be able to translate short passages into English.
