Main learning steps	To be able to talk about where you live and the weather; to know when to use <i>dans, en, au, à la, aux</i>	To be able to describe your area; <i>on peut</i> + infinitive	To be able to say what you do to help at home; <i>devoir</i> + infinitive	To be able to talk about your daily routine; reflexive verbs	To be able to talk about moving home; to be able to say where you would like to live using the conditional tense	To be able to talk about exploring new areas	To be able to write an email describing your area and your daily life using a range of opinions and references to the present, past and future tenses.
