For information: Year 11 Mock Timetable

Thank you for attending our parent's information evening last week. We have uploaded the resources we shared onto our website for you to be able to discuss with your child at home.

Your child has been working with their teachers and form tutors to prepare for the up coming exam season and subject specialists have been discussing with your child both; how best to revise in their subject area **and** where to go, what resources to use. All students have access to our online revision resource, and they can use dedicated form time sessions to work on their revision. [Link here](#)

For your child to effectively revise we would encourage they follow this checklist:

1. Make a revision timetable – set aside 2 - 3 hours a-day to revise
2. Ensure you use topic lists/learning journeys to RAG the topics in advance of making your timetable
3. Be specific with your timetable. E.g. don't just write Monday, 5pm – Maths. Change this to Monday 5pm – Simultaneous Equations
4. Plan in regular breaks
5. When revising avoid distractions
6. Use the revision strategies as memory aids; mind mapping, cheat sheets, mnemonics, flash cards and so on.

What can you do to support?

Every child needs a cheerleader, support them by giving them praise, holding them to account and asking questions about how their revision is going.

Below is a copy of the full timetable. Your child will only sit the exams that they study and they receive a personalised copy of their timetable to support their organisation.
